OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Engagement of Professor of Practice in North Eastern Regional Institute of Water and Land Management (NERIWALM), Tezpur, Assam.

NERIWALM, Tezpur, Assam is a premier organization under the Department of Water Resources, Ministry of Jal Shakti, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Govt. of India, conducting multidisciplinary activities in Water Resource Management, Irrigation Management, Agriculture and Horticulture, Soil & Water Conservation etc. NERIWALM proposes to fill up the following vacancy:

- 1. Eligibility:** Interested candidates who are citizens of India and fulfil the eligibility criteria given below may apply.

Essential:

- a. Retired Senior Engineers (holding post of Chief Engineer/ Additional Chief Engineer/ Superintending Engineer or equivalent at the time of retirement) who had served in the State Governments of Assam/Meghalaya/ Mizoram/Tripura.
- b. Should not exceed 64 years of age as on the last date for receipt of application against this advertisement.

Desirable: Experience of working in the state for irrigation development /water resource management.

2. Objectives

- i. To develop courses and curriculum to meet the Institute and societal needs and enable the Institute to work with distinguished persons on joint research projects and consultancy services which will be mutually beneficial.
- ii. To bring in distinguished experts from the field of engineering for bringing sufficient field experience to the Institute.
- iii. To enable the Institute to formally associate with persons of eminence and encourage them to participate in experiential learning, research, training, skill development, entrepreneurship and capacity building, and to play a mentoring role.

3. Tenure

The engagement shall be initially for up to one year. At the end of the initial engagement or subsequent extension, NERIWALM will make an assessment and take the decision about extension. The Institute will devise its own assessment procedure for extension based on the contribution and requirement of the persons engaged as Professors of Practice.

The maximum duration of service of 'Professor of Practice' shall not exceed three years and is extendable by one year in exceptional cases. The total period of engagement should not exceed four years under any circumstances.

4. Duties and Responsibilities:

- i. **Teaching and Training:** Conducting lectures, seminars, and workshops on water management, infrastructure planning, and sustainable land-use practices. Mentoring students and junior faculty members on practical aspects of engineering and management.
- ii. **Research Collaboration:** Leading or collaborating on research projects focused on practical, region-specific challenges in water and land management, leveraging their real-world experience.
- iii. **Field Engagement:** Actively participating in on-the-ground projects, working with local authorities, communities, and stakeholders to develop and implement water management solutions.
- iv. **Policy Input and Advocacy:** Providing expert input for policy-making discussions, creating actionable recommendations for improving governance, planning, and infrastructure management in the states of NER.
- v. **Project Implementation:** Advising on the design, planning, and execution of major water and land management projects, including flood control, irrigation, and soil conservation initiatives.

5. General Conditions

- a. The engagement of 'Professor of Practice' will be for a fixed term.
- b. The engagement of 'Professor of Practice' will be exclusive of the sanctioned posts of the Institute. It will not affect the number of sanctioned posts and the recruitment of regular faculty members.

6. Duty Days and Remuneration

- i. **Duty Days:** The 'Professor of Practice' will be stationed in his/her respective State. Assignments/Projects shall be allotted to him/her by NERIWALM and each of such allotted Assignment/Project shall be for a specific period as decided by the Competent Authority of NERIWALM. The period of such Assignment/Project during

which the 'Professor of Practice' actually performs his/her duty shall be counted as 'Duty Days' for remuneration and other related purposes.

- ii. **Remuneration:** He/she shall be paid an honorarium @ Rs. 3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand Only) for each Duty Day, subject to a maximum ceiling of Rs. 51,000/- (Rupees Fifty-One Thousand Only) per month.
- iii. **House Rent Allowance (HRA):** No HRA shall be admissible.
- iv. **Transport Allowance:** An appropriate and fixed amount as Transport Allowance for the purpose of commuting between residence and the place of work shall be allowed not exceeding the rate applicable to the appointee at the time of retirement. The amount so fixed shall remain unchanged during the term of appointment.
- v. **Dearness Allowance:** No Dearness Allowance shall be allowed.
- vi. **Increment:** The amount of remuneration fixed shall remain unchanged for the term of the contract. There will be no annual increment/percentage increase during the contract period.
- vii. **TA/DA on Tour:** Entitlement of TA/DA on Tour will be treated as equivalent to Level-13 officers of NERIWALM. Director, NERIWALM, will be the approving authority.

7. Submission of Applications

Interested candidates fulfilling the eligibility criteria given above shall send their applications in the prescribed format (enclosed as Annexure-I) to the Director, NERIWALM, Dolabari, Tezpur, District – Sonitpur, Assam – 784 027, so as to reach this institute within 45 days from the date of issue of this O.M. Applications received after the stipulated shall not be considered.

8. Selection Process

- a) The applications will be considered by a Selection Committee constituted by NERIWALM for the purpose. Based on the recommendations of this Committee, the Competent Authority of NERIWALM will decide the engagement.
- b) The candidates may be called for an interaction (either on physical mode or on online mode, as decided by Director, NERIWALM). No TA/DA will be provided by NERIWALM to the candidates for attending the interaction.

9. **Right of NERIWALM:** NERIWALM has the right to cancel the advertisement at any stage. It is not obligated to engage a Professor of Practice, even after inviting applications. It may accept or reject any or all applications without giving any reason thereof, whatsoever.
