INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

- i. Candidate MUST bring a recent valid photo ID proof like Aadhaar Card, Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID.
- ii. There will be one common test paper for the post of Laboratory Assistant (WRE), Field Assistant (WRE) and Technical Assistant (WRE) based on the evaluation of which a common merit list shall be prepared.
- iii. Candidates shall be permitted to appear for the examination ONLY after verification of their credentials by the centre officials.
- iv. To facilitate the verification of their identity, candidates must report at the examination venue at least 60 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination.
- v. Candidates will be permitted to occupy their seats 40 minutes before the scheduled start of the examination.
- vi. CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO appear 10 minutes after start of the exam.
- vii. Candidates will NOT be permitted to leave the examination hall before end of exam.
- viii. Candidates should NOT bring any calculators/ mobile phones/ charts/tables/papers/books/sheets into the examination hall.
- ix. During the examination, candidates may be checked for possession of any of the prohibited items. If the candidate is found to possess any of the prohibited items, candidate will be debarred from the examination and/or subjected to disciplinary action, which may include ban from appearing in future examinations.
- x. Candidates must bring their own pen, pencil, transparent water bottle and transparent pocket size hand sanitizer.
- xi. Without proper face MASK in place, the entry of the candidate in the examination centre shall be PROHIBITED. MASK must be in proper position throughout candidate's presence in the examination hall. Before entry to the examination centre, the centre officials may assess the health condition of the candidate.
- xii. All candidates MUST adhere to the COVID related protocols in compliance with the orders and directives of Government of India and local administration.
